Fees

Fee includes two 3 hour classes (two 2-1/2 hour classes for Sea Fleas), Interclub racing, and Friday Events.

** If a child is not a Full Family or Junior member of BPYC s/he must enroll with a youth membership.

One week is possible in Sea Fleas only, depending on availability. One week rate will be 70% of 2 week rate.

Payment Policies

Full payment is due with registration; no registration will be accepted without full payment, completed registration and medical forms. Refunds can only be made at the time of receipt of class assignment information.

Requirements

- All children, except Sea Fleas, must know how to swim. A swim test is part of the program.
- All children **MUST** have a Coast Guard approved life jacket (PFD) that fits. Type III (vest) is preferred. The PFD must be brought to every class and sailing event and worn when in boats or on floats, ramps or piers. No PFD = No Sailing, No Exceptions
- Children must be well behaved and not act in a manner that threatens their safety or the safety of others.

Parents should understand that sailing does involve certain risks and hazards. Storms do occur, boats do capsize and accidents do happen. Parents are expected to convey to their children the importance of safe, responsible behavior around boats and the water and to support the teaching of boating and water safety.

It is understood in registering your child in BPYC's Junior Sailing Program that you will be asked to volunteer a minimum of one class session to the Parent of the Day program for every 2 weeks your child is enrolled, with a maximum requirement of two class sessions for the season.

In consideration of the admission of my child(ren) to the Biddeford Pool Yacht Club Junior Sailing Program, I hereby waive and relinquish any claim or claims against the Biddeford Pool Yacht Club, its officers, trustees, employees and agents for injury or accident affecting said child(ren) occurring during the participation of said child(ren) in said program. It is also understood that I assume all normal risks of participation in said program.
